Generation One

1. Johann Sr. LITTAU was born in 1765 in Pretzk, Pommerania, Prussia. He married Anna Elisabeth Guenther circa 1795 and had been a farmer in Krim, Poland, but in 1814 immigrated to Tarutino, Bessarabia, and became the original owner of farm #109 with 60 hectares (148 Acres) of land. On 20 Mar 1817 Johann gave over the farm to his son-in-law David Fischer (who gave the farm to his brother Gorrfried in 1819). In 1820 Johann moved to Arcis, Bessarabia and after his wife died in 1841 Johann married Louisa Sperling on 22 Feb 1842 in Arcis, Bessarabia. He died after 1842 in Nue Arcis, Bessarabia.

Friedrich Sr. LITTAU (*Johann*) was born on 20 Feb 1796 in Kummi, Poland and in 1814 emigrating from Kummi and was the original owner of farm #77 with 60 hectares (148 acres) of land in Tarutino, Bessarabia. He married Louise Warnke on 12 Feb 1818 in Tarutino and they appeared on the census of 1 Apr 1835 in Tarutino and again on the censuses of 15 Sep 1850 and 17 Jan 1859. He died on 17 Feb 1864 in Tarutino, Bessarabia, at age 67.

- ix. Karl was born on 3 Sep 1842 in Tarutino, Bessarabia. Between 1850 and 1877 Karl Littau was ill with the falling sickness (epilepsy) and remained under the care of the farm until his death in Tarutino on 18 Sep 1877 at age 35.
- x. Justine was born on 16 Jan 1846 in Tarutino, Bessarabia.

Generation Three

3. Martin Sr. LITTAU (*Friedrich, Johann*) was born on 11 Nov 1822 in Tarutino, Bessarabia. He married Anna 'Susanna' Fredrich, daughter of Michael Fredrich and Anna Elisabeth Schultz, on 25 Oct 1845 in Kloetstitz, Bessarabia, According to her obituary this union produced 17 children of which only 4 lived to adulthood. He appeared on the census of 17 Jan 1859 in Tarutino. After the death of his father in 1864, Martin took over farm #77. He immigrated on 22 Feb 1875 to Eigenfeld, North Caucasus and at that time the farm was sold to Johann Flaig from Alt-Postal in accordance with the community act of 22 Feb 1875 No. 8. He died before 1893 in Kronental, North Caucasus.

4. Martin Jr. LITTAU (*Martin, Friedrich, Johann*) was born on 1 Nov 1849 in Tarutino, Bessarabia. He married Anna Christina Krueger, daughter of Gottlob Krueger and Karoline Kittler, on 9 Nov 1873 in Tarutino, Bessarabia. He immigrated with his parents to Kronental, North Caucasus where he died after 1906.

5. Samuel LITTAU (*Martin, Martin, Friedrich, Johann*) was born on 6 Jan 1877 in Markosovka, Kuban, North Caucasus. He married Louisa Wonnenberg, daughter of Ludwig Wonnenberg Sr. and Wilhelmina Bauch, circa 1899 in North Caucasus and was a teacher at that time. Samuel immigrated to the USA arriving at Ellis Island, New York, on 19 May 1900. Samuel's passport included his family that was issued in Stavropol, North Caucasus Russia in Feb 1900. The ships manifest indicates that they would join Louisa's parents in Oklahoma. He took up farming and had children born in Woodward, OK.

In Oct 1908 Samuel Littau immigrated to the Hanna district, Alberta, Canada. This Littau family went to Canada along with Louisa's brother Ludwig Jr. Wonenberg and two sisters Dorothea (John Quast) and Justina Koenig and their families along with her mother Wilhelmina Bauch Wonnenberg. They went to Hanna, Alberta to homestead except Justina stayed in Calgary where Grandma Wonnenberg stayed with Justina's family. On 2 Apr 1909 Samuel made application for entry for a homestead located SE 7-24-7 W4M. On 10 Apr 1912 Samuel made application for land title for the homestead. The application indicated that he had cultivated 28, 12, 60 acres and cropped 0, 40 and 55 acres in the years 1909, 10 and 11. It also indicated that they had 5 horses and 3 cattle by 1912. At the application date the family had a 12 X 14 sod house; a 16 X 33 sod barn; a chicken house; a stable; a water well and 320 rods of fencing. It also indicates that Sam had become a British subject by naturalization. Anton Dofer was the sponsor of this application. A patent for title of the land was issued the Department of the Interior on 31 May 1912. In 1918 Samuel was listed as one of the premier members of the Seven Day Adventist congregation in the Sponden, Alberta. He immigrated in 1923 to Filer, Idaho, USA. After all that hard work Sam and his brother-in-law Ludwig Wonnenberg gave up farming in Canada and moved their family to Idaho and in 1933 he bought a farm near Filer, but the timing was not right and he had to sell out in 1934 because of the depression. He appeared on the census of 10 Apr 1930 in Twin Falls, Idaho. In 1934 they retired in Lodi, CA and Samuel died on 13 Aug 1963 at the home of his daughter Delia, in Ashland, Oregon, USA at age 86. He was buried on 19 Aug 1963 in Cherokee Memorial Park, Lodi, CA.

He died on 11 Aug 1987 in Twin Falls, ID, at age 87 and was buried on 14 Aug 1987 in Twin Falls, ID.
